My name is [REDACTED] and I am a Senior Social Worker based at [REDACTED]

I have been working jointly with Gary with [REDACTED] for several months with [REDACTED] who is a young [REDACTED] year old with complex needs

Organisation/ Communication

Gary has been able to organise and respond appropriately to the needs of the young people he works with by ensuring that essential appointments are met and that he has been in attendance to support in advocating and allowing the young person to feel empowered when making decisions.

Through this I have observed that at times this can be difficult to manage and challenging. However Gary has been able to demonstrate through his good communication skills by developing trusting working relationships that he has been able to respond to the presenting needs of the young people he supports .

Gary is able to show that he can be sensitive to the needs of the young people and takes into account that at times they present at various levels of crisis . Gary has been able to work within their pace to achieve best outcomes in the interest of the young people . This is by organising and meeting timescales and sharing relevant information to the professional network.

Communication

Gary has been able to respond in crisis to young people and has ensured that safeguarding concerns are shared with the professional network. This has been achieved through emails , monthly reports and regular phone calls.

Gary has ensured that he is able to provide early intervention support and has attended all professional meetings required giving clear and concise information to the professional arena. There are times when I have requested support from Gary and without a second thought he has worked in partnership with [REDACTED] which have at times prevented concerns escalating further . It is evident from his work that he is a very experienced worker within his field . Gary has been able to ensure that not only is information shared with Newham but is also cascaded to Green Harvest Team for continuity and Safeguarding support and this is essential to our working in partnership

This weekend, we suspected could be difficult due to it being [redacted] 14th Birthday on the 10th however we used this opportunity to celebrate [redacted] and staff went out and purchased some birthday banners along with a birthday card. [redacted] held a small party which included music, dancing and singing.

Over the weekend, [redacted] wanted to share some of her story with others in the way of a speech which she wrote and agreed for me to share with the network (see attached) [redacted] typed this up all herself.

Yesterday [redacted] when out for dinner, played bowling and then spend some time in the arcades (some pictures are attached).

[redacted] has recognised that her behaviour has been outstanding and the staffing team has been reinforcing the positivity which is shining through. [redacted] appears very happy, calm and relaxed which is really lovely to see considering the last couple of months. We are aware that it is early days but I feel information like this should also be shared.

On Friday, [redacted] decided that she did not want to eat meat or drink any fizzy drink for a month. 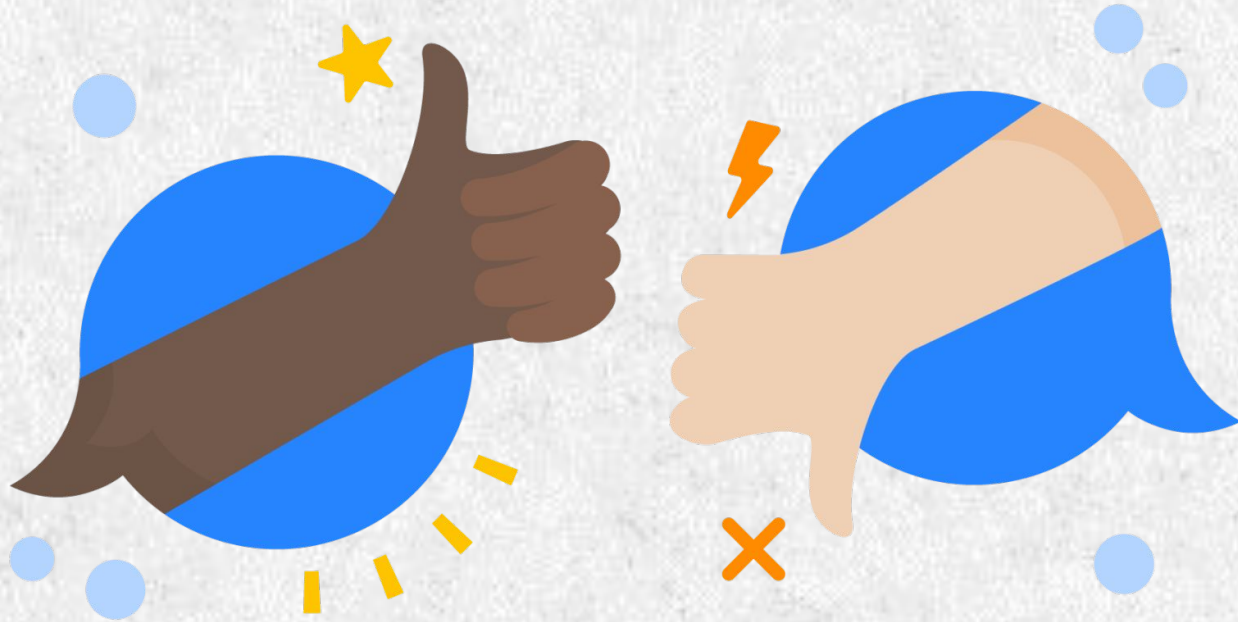
